



Dear Pastor,

Most likely you have people in your congregation that love and pray for a prodigal. This letter is to introduce you to the Prayer for Prodigals ministry.

If your church includes those praying for prodigals, let me encourage you to do two things:

1. Start a time of prayer for them to meet and pray together in agreement, because there is power in agreement (Matthew 18:19). You and/or your church members can receive scriptural prayer starters each week to use during the time of prayer or during individual prayer times. A sign-up sheet is provided for your church's use on the Resource page of the website, or each person can write me at prayerforprodigals7@gmail.com.
2. Share the links with them for three sources of encouragement:
